BACKGROUD .

As part of the university's upcoming fair there will be a conference, Thaksin University, Phatthalung Campus has decided to organize its first International Conference on Rubber, in collaboration with two French research institutes and two Thai research institutes. This conference will take place in the main rubber producing area in Thailand.

Ahead of global changes, the dynamics of the Natural Rubber sector vary between the different South and South-east Asian countries, where more than 90% of the rubber tree plantations are located. So far, the major part of natural rubber is still produced by smallholders. Therefore, the main question raised in this conference is: in a changing environment which research can help the smallholders, to strengthen their role in the rubber sector?

The international conference will give the opportunity for researchers, scientists, policy makers and other stakeholders involved in the rubber industry to get together and share their experiences in rubber. Research activities agendas shall be enriched. This conference will also contribute to the strengthening of a rubber research network in the sub-region.



CONFERENCE THEMES

The conference will focus on 4 dimensions of the rubber sector:

- 1) Biology and Agronomy of rubber production (Plant material and plantation management including latex harvesting)
 - Genetics, biotechnology and breeding
 - Agricultural practices (planting, management in immature phase, soil fertility, disease and insect management)
 - Tree physiology and latex harvesting methods
 - Ecophysiology of rubber plantations and adaptation to global changes
- 2) Socio-Economic (Social and economic issues related to natural rubber production) and plantation management including latex harvesting)
 - Land use changes and competitions
 - Labor issues (including labor contracts)
 - Viability and resilience of rubber smallholdings
 - Innovations and transfer of technology
 - Marketing and value chain analysis
- 3) Rubber Technology (Biochemistry of natural rubber and effect of non-isoprene, structure and properties of natural rubber)
 - Transformation of rubbers or elastomers into useful products
 - Structures and properties of natural rubber
 - Novel technologies for modifications of natural rubber
 - Compounding, processing, structures and properties of natural rubber
 - Rubber blends and composites
 - Rubber nanotechnology
 - Science and engineering of natural rubber surface
- 4) Environment and Public Health Issues (Impact of rubber production and transformation on health and environment)
 - Environmental impact and ecological services of rubber plantations - Environmental and public health issues in the rubber industry
 - Rubber industry health and safety
 - Occupational health of rubber tappers
 - Rubber innovation for health care
