The Asian Horticultural Congress: AHC was initiated by the Horticultural Societies of 3 countries: the People's Republic of China, the Republic of Korea, and Japan. Consultations were held in mid 2007 to seek avenues of cooperation and exchanges of knowledge on research and development connected with horticulture at the regional level through quadrennial conferences. The first conference (AHC2008) was organized during 11-13 December 2008 in Jeju, the Republic of Korea and the second conference (AHC2016) was convened in Chengdu, Sichuan province of the People's Republic of China during 26-28 September 2016. At the AHC2016, it was agreed that AHC2020 will be held in Thailand.

AHC2020's Objectives

- 1. To provide the platform for horticulturists, researchers, young scientists, entrepreneurs and those connected with horticulture and its industry to share their R&D and innovation
- 2. To showcase Thailand's horticulture at international level
- 3. To create a network of technical cooperation among Asian horticultural researchers, as well as to enhance trading in Asian region
- 4. To promote economic and social cooperation, culture and tourism domestically and internationally
