Agreement for Academic Cooperation and Exchange
between
Maejo University
and
National Chiayi University

Maejo University (MJU), Thailand and National Chiayi University (NCYU), Taiwan (hereinafter referred to individually as Party, and jointly as the Parties) do hereby agree to cooperate on the development and implementation of mutually beneficial academic activities.

1. The following agreement shall be referred to as the Exchange Agreement between National Chiayi University and Maejo University.

Aims and Objectives

2. To promote research, education and culture, and to contribute toward the mutual interests and development of both institutions, National Chiayi University and Maejo University, based on mutual trust, confirm the following Exchange Agreement.

Contents

3. Both institutions will promote the following activities based on mutual educational needs:
 - (1) Exchange of faculty and staff
 - (2) Exchange of undergraduate/graduate students
 - (3) Exchange of academic materials and other information
 - (4) Participation in seminars and academic meetings
 - (5) Joint research activities and publications
 - (6) Special short-term academic programs
 - (7) Other educational exchanges

Observance of Laws and Agreements

4. The parties shall observe the following protocols:
 - (1) This agreement shall be carried out according to the laws of Taiwan and the Kingdom of Thailand.
 - (2) Both institutions agree to obey the laws of each domain while the agreement is in effect.
5. Both institutions shall conduct activities based on this agreement after through

discussion and consent in each instance.


6. In carrying out this agreement, both institutions agree to maintain mutual autonomy and place no restrictions on each other.
7. This agreement is subject to modification or revision by mutual consent.
8. This agreement will remain in effect for five years as of the signature date, at which time it will be reviewed. Either party can effect its termination by giving six months' notice before the term expires. Otherwise, the agreement shall remain in effect under these same conditions to be renewed thereafter once every five years.
9. This agreement shall be written in English.
10. Each institution shall retain on copy of this agreement.
11. This agreement shall be effective from the date when the representatives from both institutions sign and date it.
