

## MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN FACULTY OF AGRICULTURE YAMAGUCHI UNIVERSITY, JAPAN AND



## FACULTY OF AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION MAEJO UNIVERSITY, THAILAND

Faculty of Agriculture, Yamaguchi University and Faculty of Agricultural Production, Maejo University, recognizing the benefits accruing to their respective faculties from the establishment of strong international relationship, hereby conclude this agreement.

- 1 The purpose of this agreement is to develop academic and educational collaboration and to promote friendly relations between the two faculties.
- 2 Both faculties undertake to promote and develop cooperation with various activities such as those listed below, on a basis of equality and reciprocity.
  - (1) Exchange of faculty and administrative staff members
  - (2) Exchange of undergraduate and graduate students
  - (3) Exchange of academic information and publications
  - (4) Conducting of colloquia, lectures and seminars
  - (5) Cooperation in research and the presentation of its results
  - (6) Other cooperative activities mutually agreed by both faculties
- 3 In order to give effect to these forms of cooperation, representative faculties and individual institutes within the two faculties, will be encouraged to consult with each other and to develop specific plans for collaboration in any or all of the ways mentioned in Clause 2 above.
- 4 It is understood that the implementation of any of the types of cooperation stated in Clause 2 above shall depend upon the availability of resources and financial support at the faculties concerned.
- 5 This agreement will come into effect on the date when the representatives of both faculties affix their signatures to the agreement and shall be valid for a period of five years. The validity of the agreement may be extended after discussion by representatives of both faculties; such discussion shall be commenced not later than six months before the termination of this agreement.
- 6 The agreement may at any time be revised or modified within that period by mutual consent. It may be terminated within the period by either party giving six months notice to the other.

## SUPPLEMENT TO THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN

## FACULTY OF AGRICULTURE YAMAGUCHI UNIVERSITY, JAPAN AND





Faculty of Agriculture, Yamaguchi University and Faculty of Agricultural Production, Maejo University, based on the Agreement for Academic Exchange concluded between the two Faculties, agree upon the following in order to ensure the smooth implementation of the collaboration. Apart from this supplement, in the event that problems arise in the implementation of the cooperation, the two parties will consult each other on each occasion.

1. Category of students

Undergraduate and graduate course students are involved in the Agreement for Exchange between Faculty of Agriculture of Yamaguchi University and Faculty of Agricultural Production of Maejo University.

2. Period of stay

The period of stay shall be a maximum of two semesters (one academic year).

3. Number of exchange students

The number of undergraduate students or graduate course students from each university participating in this program shall be a maximum of two per year.

4. Selection of exchange students

The home university shall select students suitable to the purpose of the exchange from amongst those applying and shall recommend them to the host university.

5. Status of exchange students

Exchange students shall be treated with special distinction at the host university.

6. Accreditation of credits and grades

Credits and grades earned at the host university shall be accredited according to the rules of the home university.

7. Study program

The home university will determine the study program of the exchange students bearing in mind their study-background, in consultation with the host university.

8. Tuition, registration and screening fees

The host university shall waive the above fees for the exchange students.

9. Accommodation

The host university will endeavor to assure accommodation for the exchange students.

10. Financial responsibility

Travel expenses, accommodation and living expenses, medical expenses, etc. shall be the responsibility of the exchange students.
